

In 1919, Abraham N. Fine started The Royal Furriers. He purchased furs from local hunters and trappers and sold them to furriers in New York and Massachusetts. In 1928, Fine began making and selling ready-made coats as well as repairing his customers' fur coats. His two delivery vehicles are pictured in front of the store that was located on Main Street in Keene, circa 1930. In the late 1960s, the store continued under other owners and names for more than three decades. The last business, Keene Furs and Fashions, was under the ownership of Robert and Carol Green.
